Waldzell Meeting: FORMAT is awarding six scholarships

Twelve of the world's brightest heads are coming together on 11 and 12 September at Melk Abbey to exchange ideas and engage in a dialog on the search for meaning. The organizers of the Waldzell Meeting, taking place this year for the first time, were able to attract three Nobel Prize laureates, among others, including Shirin Ebadi, the American happiness researcher Mihaly Csikszentmihalyi, the quantum physicist Anton Zeilinger and star baritone Thomas Hampson. In forums and private discussions with the participants, they will explore the question of how enterprises today must examine the search for meaning. FORMAT is giving away six scholarships for the Meeting (information at www.waldzell.org): Six applicants who are able to plausibly describe their special interest in the topic and in one of the keynote speakers, can take part free of charge.
