## Paulo Coelho in Vienna and Melk

### In search for meaning

The bookshop Morawa in the Vienna Wollzeile is already decorated with a Coelho- poster "The Pilgrimage", one of the Brazilian author's best-selling books. Today, Thursday, at 11 o'clock, he is opening the section of the Pilgrimage between Göttweig Abbey and Melk Abbey. Tomorrow he will be discussing the "limitations of science" with the Viennese quantum physicist Anton Zeilinger and the German-born, now American medical Nobel Prize laureate and genetic researcher Gunter Blobel. An event hosted by "Waldzell Dialogs" on science and spirituality, in co-operation with the Vienna University and Kurier. Afterwards there will be an open discussion.

"We do not have the answer to everything, but we have to start asking the right questions and finding the best answers", is the motto of the event. The gap between science and spirituality should be bridged.
